

**Medical Cannabis Day at the Legislature – LOB, Raleigh, February 12, 2013**  
**Legislative Report Form**

Instructions: This sheet will be used to record our visits and lobbying at the Legislature on February 12. Remember to be polite at all times and to end the interview with a kind word to your legislator even if the legislator refuses to answer. If you are fortunate to be meeting with a supporting legislator, please ask if they will sponsor the bill. If you visit a legislator who opposes a safe and compassionate medical cannabis program, please ask why and list reasons on this report so we can address these concerns. Politely inquire if NCCPN can schedule a follow up visit to educate. If completely unreceptive, please thank your legislator and politely exit quickly and move on. Arguing or challenging the legislator's opposing view will only hurt our cause. If the legislator will not commit to a position for or against, or is unwilling to discuss, please ask them if we can arrange for a visit at a later date to help educate them on the issue. NCCPN will schedule a follow up appointment and can arrange for patients, a doctor, or nurse to visit. Note: If legislator is "undecided" yet refuses to schedule follow up "education" appt, we will publish this as "opposed, but unwilling to admit this to constituents". All of the reported information will be published.
